

WANTED
Medical Coordination Support
for Bosnia
Starting Date: 01 March (earlier start preferred)

We run a field project in Bosnia as part of a German NGO providing medical aid along the Balkan route. Our work is highly mobile and mainly takes place in squats and informal structures.

Following a recent restructuring of the project, we are currently realigning our operations on the ground. As part of this process, we are introducing a new role to support our Balkans medical coordination team, which is largely working remotely and cannot always be present on site.

The Medical Coordination Support will play a key role in coordinating the daily medical activities on the ground and act as a bridge between the medical volunteers team in Bosnia and the remote medical coordination team, who will be on call to provide support when needed.

On site, you will work together with up to two additional medical volunteers. You will also be supported by a local administrative manager who assists with day-to-day operational matters.

Location: Bihac, Bosnia

Type of contract: Voluntary contribution 500€ per month, duration 3 months (tourist visa)

Tasks:

- Contact person for MVI in Bosnia on the ground
- Regular reporting to the Balkan coordination team and head office/executive board
- Very close cooperation with the coordination team and the project management/executive board and local CEO
- Budget monitoring and management
- streighten partnerships and collaboration on the ground

- Developing new ways to reach people in need more effectively

Requirements:

90 days free entry in Bosnia must be guaranteed. This means that you have not been in Bosnia in the last 180 days.

- Medical background is required
- Experience in the field of humanitarian aid and/or health care
- Knowledge of project work
- Human rights activism
- Strong communication and teamwork skills
- Fluency in English; knowledge of German and/or Bosnian an advantage
- Driving license
- Appropriate boundaries at work and adherence to the Code of Conduct.
- Commitment and awareness of migration issues and dealing with the needs of POMs within the European borders
