



Call for Applications – LEROS

Mobile Medical Care for People Seeking Protection on Leros, Greece

Medical Solidarity International e. V. is launching a three-month pilot project in spring 2026 to provide mobile primary healthcare for people seeking protection on the Greek island of Leros.

Currently, more than 1,000 people live in the Closed Controlled Access Centre (CCAC) on Leros. Since the withdrawal of Médecins Sans Frontières last year, there has been no continuous NGO presence and, according to current information, no reliable ongoing medical care inside the camp. An assessment conducted by our team in December 2025 confirmed that the medical need is significant — and that a mobile, low-threshold intervention is both feasible and urgently required.

For this project, we are looking for committed medical professionals to join our team.

The pilot phase will focus on establishing a flexible, mobile healthcare service with:

- A mobile medical setup (own van)
- Regular presence near the CCAC
- Basic primary care, triage, first assessment, and referral
- Optional psychosocial first support depending on team capacity
- Close coordination with our Greece/Kos coordination team
- Potential linkage to our existing activities on Kos

The project operates entirely in a mobile setting — consultations will primarily take place directly from our vehicle.

The project team will consist of three medical professionals working closely together on site: **One Medical Coordination Support** who will stay for the full three months and ensure medical and operational continuity and **two Medical Volunteers** who will join for a minimum of three weeks each (longer stays are very welcome).



The team will work in a small, highly collaborative setting with shared responsibility. Due to the mobile nature of the project, flexibility, strong communication, and mutual support are essential.

Open Positions

1. Medical Coordination Support (Paid Position)

Duration: Full 3 months on site

Compensation: 500 € per month

Start date: Around 16 March 2026 (flexible until April)

Responsibilities

- On-site medical co-ordination of the project in close collaboration with the Greece/Kos coordination
- Structuring and organizing daily mobile operations
- Acting as liaison between the field team and coordination
- Documentation and reporting
- Supporting clinical activities when needed

Profile

- Medical background (e.g., physician, nurse, public health professional, or similar)
- Driving licence and driving experience
- Experience in humanitarian, migration, or low-threshold healthcare settings is highly desirable
- Strong ability to work independently and adapt to dynamic environments
- Good command of English
- Availability to stay on Leros for the full three-month period



2. Medical Volunteers (2 Positions)

Duration: Minimum 3 weeks (longer stays very welcome)

Start: Flexible within the project timeframe

Responsibilities

- Provision of basic primary healthcare
- Triage and first medical assessment
- Documentation of consultations
- Referral to local health structures when necessary

Profile

- Physicians, nurses, or other qualified medical professionals
- Driving licence and driving experience
- Experience working with displaced populations or in low-threshold settings is an asset
- Ability to work independently in small teams
- Strong team spirit and resilience in intensive working environments
