About us

Medical Solidarity International (MSI) e.V. is a non-profit, politically active organization working at the intersection of health and migration. We advocate for equal access to healthcare and social participation for people on the move and those living in precarious conditions.

Our work is grounded in the belief that health is a human right and that a just and solidaristic society takes responsibility for protection, dignity, and participation for all. We are active both along the EU's external borders and within Germany.

Purpose of the Internship

This internship offers you the opportunity to gain insight into event work within a politically active NGO. You will learn the basic processes of event organization and develop an understanding of civil society engagement in the context of migration, health, and human rights.

Your Tasks & Learning Areas

During the internship, you will support the team under guidance in:

- Conceptualizing, planning, and preparing events and actions
- Supporting organizational and coordination processes in the event context
- Gaining insight into internal communication and collaborative workflows
- Creating informational and event materials
- Assisting in the implementation and follow-up of events
- Supporting basic documentation and evaluation processes

The focus is on gaining practical experience and foundational knowledge.

- Collaboration within a committed and supportive team
